All three cabins and saloon, including the cockpit, on board Carte Blanche are fully air-conditioned and can be maintained to your desired temperature. In the cockpit you will find a very convenient glass storage cupboard and for those ice cold drinks a large cooler. To cool your drinks even more there is an icemaker. For the dedicated sun worshippers, and at the touch of a button, virtually the entire cockpit roof opens up. For those who do not wish to go ashore for their evening meal an electric BBQ is built into the cockpit. The fully fitted galley includes dishwasher, combination microwave oven, 4-ring halogen hob and an extremely large fridge. If the sun gets too hot then enjoy the comfort of the spacious air conditioned saloon and watch the 26 inch flat screen television or just listen to your favourite CD. (Separate CD in cockpit) All cabins have their own TV and video player and the master and forward cabins have their own en-suite facilities. The smaller port cabin has its own shower and toilet and this also acts as a day head. The Captain has his own toilet and shower attached to his cabin down aft, so is independent of guests.


Also on board, we have a freezer and automatic washing machine, and just in case you should get bored, satellite TV.

Carte Blanche for your safety and pleasure




To be able to relax and enjoy your private cruise you must be extremely confident in the boat and it's equipment. To this end Carte Blanche is one of the very few V65's that has passed and been awarded the MCA Coding certificate for charter use (Maritime & Coastguard Agency) This is a stringent set of rules and modifications that have to be carried out on the boat to meet their safety standards. With this MCA certificate Carte Blanche is registered as a commercial vessel (not pleasure vessel) for the use of private charters. You can be assured that a qualified surveyor, on an annual basis, has inspected all the safety equipment on board, life rafts, fire fighting systems, flares etc, ensuring they are up to the MCA's stringent standards.

To enable you to follow your progress and know your exact position at any given time we have on board the latest Global Positioning navigation system. This consists of a moving map type display integrated with the autopilot. This map display is also connected to the electronic radar, which is a major safety feature as it enables the Captain to track other vessels in your area. VHF radio telephone is also installed.

There are two garages in the stern, the port one containing an Avon jet rib and the starboard is used to store water skis, ring for towing behind jet rib and a canoe and snorkelling equipment. The hydraulic operated paserelle incorporates a handrail for those who are not too sure of their footing when going ashore. There is also a full set of sun bathing cushions on the aft and forward decks.
